Re: 2019/20 Juan De Fuca Minor Hockey Association (JDFMHA) Tier 1 (T1)

KPMHA Peewee, Bantam and Midget families,

Vancouver Island Amateur Hockey Association (VIAHA) has recently approved the return of the combined Tier 1 format teams for the 2019/20 playing season.

JDFMHA will host the Tier 1 team and can accept players from Juan de Fuca, Kerry Park and Sooke in the following divisions:

- PeeWee
- Bantam
- Midget

Costs

- Cost to try out for the T1 team is \$125.00 which can be e-transferred
 to office@jdfminorhockey.com or paid by cheque dropped off at the JDFMHA office located in
 the JDF arena lobby.
- If your child makes the T1 team, the season registration cost for JDF hosted T1 teams will be at JDF's regular rates.
- After team selection, each team will hold a meeting to discuss augmenting the program with additional training, support and ice with costs to be communicated in a team budget and approved by families as done with all JDF hockey teams.

How to register for JDF T1 tryouts

To try out for the Tier 1 team at JDF, players registered for representative try outs will have to declare they wish to be assessed for the Tier 1 team by completing the online form for JDF and the short online form for KPMHA, both are found below;
